HB 183 – School District Leave Policies

- **Union representatives represent the union.** HB 183 eliminates the conflict of interest inherent in working for the union and being paid by the school district
- **Taxpayers expect their dollars to be going into the classroom.** Scarce public education dollars should NOT go to union activities, including union recruitment and dues collection.
- **Union representatives are given leave from their school district duties to perform union duties.** They are doing less for the school district in order to work for the union; therefore the union should pay them.
- **Proponents say, “Union representatives often work to improve districts and ease tensions.”** HB 183 allows the union to continue providing important services to the district's curriculum, foundation, insurance or other committees that directly benefit the district. But, a union representative's primary objective is to represent the interest of the union, not the district. Therefore, their salary should reflect their allegiance.
