HB 258 – Education Funding Amendments Chief Sponsor: Kraig Powell

HB 258 would reinstate the double funding of students who spend some of their time out of the classroom and in an applied technology center.

- **Don't pay twice for same students.** When Utah's education dollars are already stretched so far, we simply can't afford to pay twice for the same students (pgs. 30-31, "A Performance Audit of Career and Technical Education Costs," 2009).
